Please read the other side of this Registration Form. It contains a waiver and release of all claims and assumption of risk while involved in the program or activity registering for shown below. I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in these programs/activities, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of

participating in these programs/activities against the Northbrook Park District including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees (hereinafter collectively referred to as Northbrook Park District).

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Northbrook Park District from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with these programs or activities.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Northbrook Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Northbrook Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for the below listed programs/activities must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities/programs.

You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

WARNING OF RISK

Swimming is a sport that challenges and engages the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including but not limited to drowning, head/brain injury and cervical spine injury. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen.

The very nature of swimming is hazardous and risky, including but not limited to fatigue and overexertion, poor swimming skills, failing to avoid dangerous areas, horseplay, diving or cannon-balling into shallow water and striking the bottom or side of the pool, poor supervision or

instruction, lack of conditioning, becoming disoriented, striking other swimmers, defective or inadequate equipment, striking one's head on the bottom when using a diving block, slipping or falling on the deck or within the locker facility, chemical exposure and all other circumstances inherent to the sport of swimming. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the District/SRA to guarantee absolute safety.

PARTICIPATION WILL BE DENIED

If the Signature of an adult participant or parent/guardian and date are not on this waiver in the space provided on the Membership/Application side of this form.

COMMITMENT TO QUALITY

At the Northbrook Park District, we want all participants to be satisfied with their recreation choices. If you are not happy with the content or instructor of a program, you may ask to repeat the class, transfer to another class or receive a refund, after filling out a Commitment to Quality form at any Registration Office.

This policy applies to recreation and cultural arts classes if the course is at least four weeks long and the participant attends the first two classes. A refund request form must be submitted before the third class. The following are exempt from this policy: Sunshine Preschool, Adventure Campus, athletic leagues, camps, clinics, costumes, passes, private lessons, tickets and trips. Those programs will utilize the basic refund policy outlined below.

REFUNDS

Call the main Registration Office at (847) 291-2980 to request a refund. Refunds will be granted:

- If the Park District cancels a program.
- If you give notice five full working days before the start of a program, unless otherwise noted in program descriptions.
- Before the first scheduled performances for Northbrook Theatre season subscriptions.
- If the instructor and participant agree that the participant's skill level is not appropriate for the program.
- After the start of a program, due
- to an illness or injury, verified in writing by a physician on an official letterhead or prescription pad.

When a refund is granted, customers who paid by cash or check will receive a refund check; those who paid by credit card will receive a credit to their charge account. Unless otherwise noted, all refunds are subject to an administrative fee of 10% of the program cost (a minimum charge of \$8), except in cases of program cancellation. Please allow two weeks for processing. All Park District Camps and Workshops have a nonrefundable deposit, specified in the Summer Camp Guide.

PHOTO/VIDEO AUTHORIZATION

The Northbrook Park District regularly video records and photographs participants enrolled in Park District programs, and classes and patrons enjoying Park District events and facilities. These photographs/videos are used in connection with promoting/advertising the services, programs and facilities of the Northbrook Park District. All photos and videos taken are for not-for-profit Park District use and become the sole property of the Park District.
