Dress Rehearsals and Tech Night are the time when the whole production comes together! Lighting is used for the first time, entrances and exits are finalized, each skater's costume is checked to make sure it is fitted properly, and group photographs are taken. Participation in all events (both dress rehearsal days and tech night) is strongly encouraged for skaters freestyle 4 and below and mandatory for all upper level groups and Icette program teams.

Attire

Participants should be in full costume, hair and make-up done, with white/black skates. Skates and laces are to be clean. Use white laces on white skates and black laces on black skates. Skaters will not be allowed to wear jewelry or hair ties that can be seen from the audience. Please make sure tights are the correct color and no holes are present. **All costume pieces will be required for a skater to be able to take the ice.**

Arrival Time

Skaters need to arrive 30 minutes prior to their skate time or picture time depending on which one comes first. Please check the table below for your skaters specific picture and skate time. Instructors and volunteers will be present to organize the skaters for their rehearsal. Each number in the show will be performed 2-3 times. ***Skaters Alpha and below will only come on Sunday May 5.**

Photos/Group Picture

The photographer will only be present during the dress rehearsal days. All skaters should come to the rink fully dressed in their costume pieces. The Multi-Purpose room will be available for skate bag storage and use throughout the day. Once the skaters have performed their number and have taken their group photo in the Community Room, an announcement in the rink will be made for parents to pick up their skaters outside of the Community Room.

Individual photos can be arranged with the photographer at the time of the skater's group photo or any other time throughout the day.

*Please follow the costume instructions attached to your costume bag. All female skaters are required to wear footed (in the boot) suntan tights. They may be purchased in Ron's Skate Shop. Skaters may be asked to fix or change a part of their costume, if necessary.

All FS 5 & Up Skaters:

*All female skaters are required to wear footed (in the boot) suntan tights with toffee colored fishnets. Footed tights and fishnets can be purchased in Ron's Skate Shop.

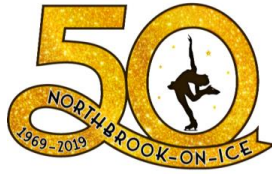

Rental Skates

If your son/daughter plans to wear rental skates/velcro skates, please purchase boot covers from Ron's Skate Shop. Girls must have white boot covers on their rental skates and boys must have black. There will be no charge for skate rentals on dress rehearsal, tech night, or the production days. Anyone renting skates must exchange their shoes which will be returned when skates are returned. Rental skates should not leave the building at any time and must be returned at the end of each performance.

This will be the first time the technical panel will be running through the set cues. Many technical adjustments will be made during Tech Night up to the first production.

Closed To The Public

Tech night will be closed to the public. This night is used to finalize any and all cues and the production will possibly be stopped and restarted if a cue needs to be altered or rehearsed an additional time. Parents may drop off their skaters or wait in "A" lobby for the skaters to perform and then return to their holding/locker rooms. If your skater is in Delta and below then they are allowed to leave once they have skated their routine, unless otherwise specified by the director.

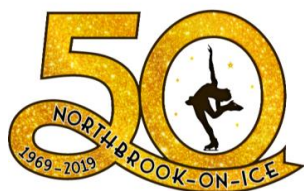
Attire

Miscellaneous Information

Costume Cover-Ups

To preserve the excitement of the show, all skaters are required to wear a full costume cover-up when not performing. This includes before the show begins, during intermission, and after the group has skated while sitting in the stands.

Video Equipment

No videotaping during the production is allowed. Each production will be professionally recorded and you may purchase a DVD out in “A” lobby at the end of the performance. The videographer will be using multiple camera angles to capture the best moments of Northbrook-On-Ice.

Cameras

No flash photography is permitted as it may interrupt a skater’s performance. All pictures must be taken while seated from your ticketed seat location.
