



Adult Softball Registration Information 2020 Fall League

Thank you for your interest in the Northbrook Park District Adult Softball Leagues. If you are no longer the team captain or representative, please pass this information on to the new team captain immediately.

Friday, August 14 is the last day for registration. If your team is not paid in full, your team will not be included on the schedule.

**League Fee: \$700
(Includes Refundable Forfeit Fee of \$50)**

Any league fee checks that are returned for “insufficient funds” or Visa/Mastercard/Discover/American Express card payments that are denied will result in that team being automatically eliminated from the league. The forfeit fee of \$50 will be returned to teams at the completion of the season if the team did not forfeit a game during the season. The forfeit fee will be returned to the individual or company who appears on the team payment form. **Unpaid balances may result in an immediate suspension from play until payment is received. Any team suspension will be considered a forfeit and the District will retain the forfeit fee.**

There will be no captains meeting for the fall season. Questions regarding rules, schedules, and league policies should be directed to the league supervisor.

All teams, whether new or returning, must submit to the Northbrook Park District the following items together in one envelope in order to be considered for league entry:

1. Completed roster with a 10-player minimum and a maximum of 20 players. Only the first 20 names on the roster are eligible. Teams playing in the Summer of 2020 may use their roster from the summer for the fall but must notify supervisor of the official team roster.
2. An Adult Softball League Team Roster/Waiver Form completed and signed by all team members by the fourth published game.

Team Admission and League Assignments

Any teams that were expelled from the league due to forfeitures, rules violations, or misconduct, the league director has the right to exclude that team for the upcoming season.

Please indicate on your team's application form the league in which you desire to play. The Northbrook Park District reserves the right to place teams in different divisions in order to equalize competition. In the event that too many teams are seeking to enter the same league, league may be split into separate leagues.

Game Schedules and Time Limits

A sixty (60) minute time limit will be in effect for 12" and 14" leagues. The umpire will begin time after captains meeting. No new inning may begin after the time-limit passes.

With the exception of Corporate Leagues, game times will vary starting as early as 6:05pm and as late as 9:30pm. Every effort will be made to ensure corporate leagues play at the same time each week.

League schedules will be posted at www.quickscores.com/northbrook. Team captains should check website frequently for standings accuracy, changes, and updates to the schedule. Make up games and playoff schedules may differ from league schedules.

Awards

League awards will be given to:

1. All regular season champions will receive top seeding into the single elimination tournament and a check for **\$250** made payable to the team captain. League runner up will receive a check for **\$150** made payable to the team captain.
2. Tournament champions will receive a plaque and a check for **\$150** made payable to the team captain. Tournament runner-up will receive a plaque.

Roster Changes

Additions to roster must be made not later than the fourth published league game. All participants must sign roster to be eligible for play.

Rain Outs

All rainouts will be re-scheduled to the following Sunday. Every attempt will be made to reschedule rain outs. Games may be rescheduled as double headers or on a different night. Leagues may be cut short due to multiple rainouts and teams will be given a prorated refund for the amount of games missed.

Once a decision has been made to cancel a game, the decision will not be reversed regardless of change in weather conditions. Umpires and park district staff will reserve the right to cancel a game for any reason due to inclement weather and field conditions.

An ASA or NSA patched umpire will be provided for all games. A new ball will also be provided for each game. The home team will keep the ball.
