RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Baseball and softball fields are available from 8am-8pm daily.
2. Fields are restricted to 1 team at a time. Small group training/team practices only. Teams may break up into multiple groups. Teams must limit group sizes to 10 including coaches/instructors.
3. Renters must have insurance and secure a permit.
4. Renters using facilities without a permit will be violating Park District ordinance and are subject to fines.
5. Before, during and after use, all participants and renters must maintain a minimum of 6 feet from other people.
6. Face coverings are recommended but not required.
7. Handling of shared equipment is prohibited.
8. No handshakes, high fives or physical contact between participants or renters.
9. Ball fields may have limited access to bathrooms and no access to drinking fountains.
10. Ball fields will not be dragged or lined.
11. No games, tournaments or other large-scale group events are permitted.
12. Rental groups must remain with their group for the entirety of their permitted time. Participants, coaches and instructors should not intermingle with other users.
13. Facility users are encouraged to place their personal items (bags, water bottles, equipment, etc.) at a safe distance (6 feet) from others to avoid any surface contact.
14. Renters are encouraged to bring and use hand sanitizer.
15. Participants should arrive no earlier than 10 minutes and must exit immediately following their use.
16. No spitting or sunflower seeds
17. All users should follow guidelines from their local and national governing bodies or Little League <https://www.littleleague.org/player-safety/coronavirus-update/season-resumption-guide/best-practices/organizing-playing-watching-games/>
18. Please be vigilant in preventing the spread of the virus by practicing good hygiene as recommended by CDC guidelines.
19. Stay at home if you are experience any symptoms as listed by the CDC Guidelines.
20. Please do not enter the ball fields if you have any symptoms or exposure risks as listed by the CDC guidelines.
