

COVID-19

Tier 3 Open Gym Rules & Regulations

1. All participants and parents/legal guardians are required to wear a face covering at all times when indoors and for the duration of the program.
2. Pre-registration and advanced payment are required to participate.
3. Due to Tier 3 mitigations, open gym is restricted to individual skill work.
4. A maximum of 6 individuals will be allowed in the gym at a time and will be assigned to a designated area.
5. Any patrons, including parents/legal guardians not registered for a Park District program are required to sign in.
6. Children under 8 and under must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian. Children 9 and older can participate without parent/guardian supervision.
7. No food or drink is allowed in the gym. Water bottles are allowed. Participants must bring their own water and cannot share.
8. Participants are required to space themselves and personal items (bags, water bottle, etc.) at a safe distance (6 feet) from others
9. Anyone wishing to speak to a Park District employee cannot come with 6' and/or must have a mask on.
10. Participants are encouraged to bring their own sports equipment. Sanitized equipment will be provided for those without sports equipment.
11. Handling of shared equipment is prohibited.
12. All participants are encouraged to bring and use hand sanitizer.
13. If you arrive early and the gym is still in use, please don't enter until the previous program has left the gym.
14. Please be vigilant in preventing the spread of the virus by practicing good hygiene as recommended by CDC guidelines.
15. All participants should conduct a daily self-assessment and not participate if:
 - a. They are feeling ill or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19
 - b. An individual or a household member has been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for, been diagnosed with or is suspected to have COVID-19
 - c. The individual has tested positive for COVID-19 and has not determined it is safe to return
16. Please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms or have had exposure risks as listed by CDC guidelines.
