NEW BUSINESS

Consider Contractor Agreements for Northbrook Sports Center Replacements, Bid #2193

On January 28, 2021, the Northbrook Park District and consultants opened 33 bids for six Bid Packages for the Northbrook Sports Center Replacements project. Bid Package #2 – Painting did not receive any bids. Contractors expressed their concerns and staff are reviewing the bid specifications. The re-bid package will be presented at a future Parks and Properties Committee Meeting. Commissioners engaged in a question and answer session. Chair Randel called for additional questions. Hearing none, Commissioner Chalem made a motion to approve Bid Package #1 Carpentry/General Trades, Bid Package #3 Roofing/Metal Panels, Bid Package #4 Mechanical/Plumbing, Bid Package #5 Electrical and Bid Package #6 Paving as presented to the full Board for approval. Commissioner Curin seconded the motion.

ROLL CALL: Chair Randel, Commissioner Chalem and Commissioner Curin voted aye.

Motion Passed: 3 ayes; 0 nays

Consider Professional Services Agreement with Corporate Construction Services for Northbrook Sports Center Replacements

Director Dalton provided background information on construction management needs for the Northbrook Sports Center Replacements project. Corporate Construction Services was involved with the renovation of the Sports Center in 2000, the 2017 Sports Center pool renovation project and most recently the Sports Center front entry renovation. Chair Randel called for questions. Hearing none, Commissioner Chalem moved to approve the Agreement for Professional Services with Corporate Construction Services of Downers Grove, Illinois for construction management services as advisor to the full Board for approval. Commissioner Curin seconded the motion.

ROLL CALL: Chair Randel, Commissioner Chalem and Commissioner Curin voted aye.

Motion Passed: 3 ayes; 0 nays

Consider Professional Services Agreement for Comprehensive Master Plan Update

The District has reached the mid-way point of the 10-year Comprehensive Master Plan. Detailed goals were outlined for the first five years of the current plan with recommendations being provided for the remaining five years. Commissioners engaged in a question and answer session. Chair Randel called for questions. Hearing none, Commissioner Chalem moved to approve the Agreement for Professional Services with Hitchcock Design Group of Naperville, Illinois for the update of the Comprehensive Master Plan, subject to final negotiation and approval by legal counsel and the Executive Director, to the full Board for approval. Commissioner Curin seconded the motion.

ROLL CALL: Chair Randel, Commissioner Chalem and Commissioner Curin voted aye.

Motion Passed: 3 ayes; 0 nays
