* Line Leaders will not have tryouts unless registration exceeds the number of line leader positions for the 2026 Ice Show. Any skater that is Freeskate 4 or higher AND ten (10) years old or older can register to be a line leader (activity code #28236). Skaters who wish to tryout for Specialty roles are encouraged to register for a line leader position once they receive their tryout results. Line leader registration will stay open longer than the other ice show registrations (until January 31).

REGISTRATION

Registration must be completed in person at the Sports Center. **Skaters must register for their current skating level at the time of registration.** If a skater advances between the time of registration and the closing date, please email Ania Lopez at alopez@nbparks.org to adjust. All costumes are ordered specifically for the skater registered. No refunds or exchanges will be made once the costumes have been ordered.

The final deadline for both Tot-Free Skate 4 and Upper Level registrations is Sunday, January 11. Costume orders are placed the next day and no orders will be taken after the registration deadline unless additional costumes are available. For any skaters wanting to register after the deadline, a \$15 late fee will be applied.

UPPER LEVEL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Skaters in levels Free Skate 5 and above are able to participate in an Upper Level group number. Skaters will choose their costume size at registration. Following the deadline on **Sunday, January 11**, specific groups will be established based on age and skating level. Skaters in an Upper Level are required to attend dress rehearsal, tech night and all five performances. Icettes are not eligible for an Upper Level number in the show. **Skaters are also required to register for both Winter Sessions or skate three hours a week beginning in November 2025*.**

*For NOI 2027, skaters will need to register for both Autumn and Winter Sessions to be eligible.

VOLUNTEERING

Skaters participating in an Upper Level group number are required to have a parent/guardian fulfill two volunteer shifts of roughly four hours each during production weekend. Shifts will be offered during dress rehearsals, tech night, and during performances.

Tot-Free Skate 4 families are not required to volunteer, but we still need your help! Northbrook-On-Ice relies on you and members of the community to assist with the production.

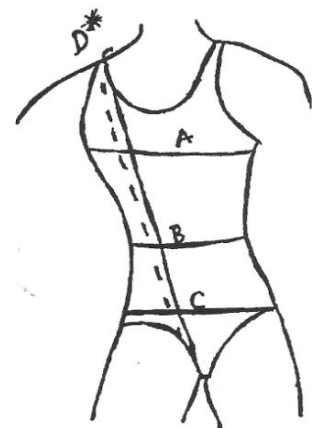
Volunteer registration will take place online starting **Wednesday, February 25**. Positions for family members may include locker and holding room attendants, Community Room & Multi-Purpose Room check-in, program sales, etc.

MEASURING YOUR SKATER

Parents/guardians are responsible for the final measurements. There are no refunds and/or exchanges on any costumes. **Keep in mind, your child may grow by May 2026!!**

- A. Chest
- B. Waist
- C. Hips
- D. Girth (right shoulder through the crotch & back up to the right shoulder)*
- E. Inseam (Boys only)

****Girth is the most important measurement***



REGISTRATION COSTUME CODES & FEES

Each group listed below has a different costume that has been chosen based on the music and choreography for this year's production and theme. Included in the fee is the costume as well as the cost of a choreographer(s) and rehearsal ice times including regular rehearsals, dress rehearsals and tech nights. Action photography and videography is included in the registration fee as well. In addition to the registration fee, all skaters will be responsible for purchasing new tights and/or fishnets (Upper Levels/specialty parts), as well as any other miscellaneous items like hair ties, v-clips and tailoring if their costume does not fit properly

REHEARSAL INFORMATION

Rehearsals are practices with an assigned choreographer(s). These times are in addition to their normal skating classes. Regular skating apparel is recommended during their rehearsals. **Costumes will be required to be worn for the last two rehearsals scheduled.** The number of rehearsals for each level have been adjusted to provide the most positive show experience possible. To ensure a great routine for all participants in your group, **please attend all scheduled rehearsals.** Parents/guardians are invited to watch these rehearsals. Skate rental charges apply. **Please see the last page for the rehearsal schedule.**

PICTURE DAY

Picture day is Saturday, April 11. All skaters participating in Northbrook-On-Ice are encouraged to attend! This picture will be included in the Northbrook-On-Ice program which is sold during each performance. All skaters should wear blue jeans, a plain white short- or long-sleeved shirt and skates for the picture. Please review your skater's individual rehearsal schedule to verify the time of their group picture. Skaters should plan to arrive early to check in for their picture. Group pictures in the skater's costume will be taken during dress rehearsal.

FINALE REHEARSALS (PRE-FREE SKATE & UP)

Skaters in Pre-Free Skate & above are invited to skate in the finale, a choreographed routine that concludes each show. Skaters will wear their group number costume for this number. Finale rehearsal times are listed below, and the detailed schedule for each level will be released in April. Attendance at all finale rehearsals is mandatory in order to participate in the number. Registration can be completed online or at the front desk and is free of charge.

DRESS REHEARSALS

Dress rehearsals are scheduled on **Saturday, May 2 and Sunday, May 3.** Dress rehearsals are final practices held in the production rink. **All skaters are required to be in full costume with hair and make-up that is "show ready."** Please refer to the instructions located inside of the costume bag for specific details about hair and costume wear. The dress rehearsals are used to create lighting cues, finalize set design, introduce props for the first time and finalize transitions. These rehearsals are designed to help the director of the show finish the full production. Group pictures in the skater's costumes will be taken during the dress rehearsal days and will be made available for purchase. A detailed dress rehearsal/picture schedule will be distributed in April. Skate rental is complimentary.

TECH NIGHT

Tech night is scheduled on **Tuesday, May 5** at 6pm. During tech night, full run-throughs of each half of the show will be performed. Final details with lighting, sounds, props, set and choreography will be made. The entire show will be run in one rehearsal with a short ice resurface break during intermission. **Tech night is for production purposes only and will be closed to the public.** Skate rental is complimentary. All Pre-Free Skate & Up skaters participating in finale will need to stay until the end!

TICKET INFORMATION

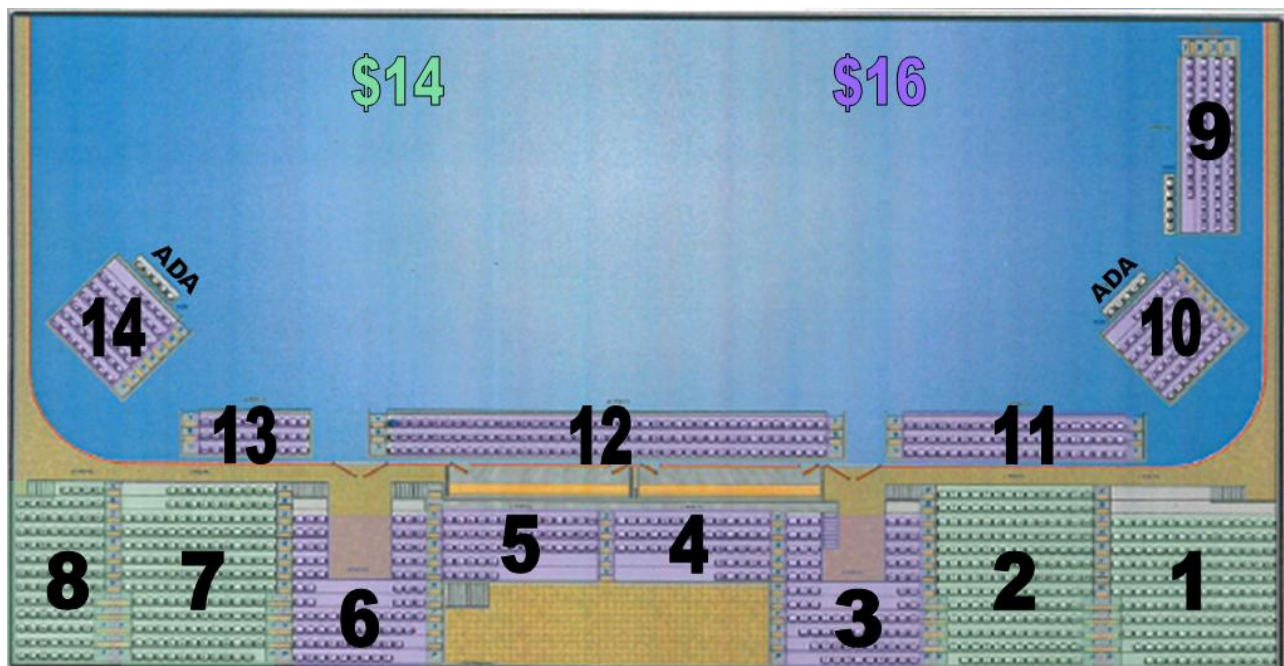
Priority ticket sales will open for Graduating Seniors and skaters in the Icette Program/Upper Level number. Groups will receive a priority code to be eligible to purchase tickets. Each individual skater is entitled to a maximum of 12 tickets TOTAL during priority ticket sales. Additional tickets may be purchased when ticket sales open to the public on **Friday, March 6.** Toddler-Free Skate 4 and SPICE skaters can purchase tickets starting **Thursday, March 5.**

PRIORITY TICKET SALES INFORMATION

- Priority ticket sales codes and more detailed information will be sent out the week of **February 23** to the email used to register your skater for Northbrook-On-Ice and/or the Icette Program. This is the only email that will have the access to purchase priority tickets.
 - Customer service staff will be monitoring the amount of tickets purchased by each skater.
 - Any misuse/sharing of priority ticket sales codes will result in forfeiture of tickets without a refund.
- Priority ticket sales are limited to 12 tickets total per skater. **For families with multiple skaters, separate emails will need to be registered.**
- Priority ticket sales begin as outlined below:
 - Graduating Seniors starting **Monday, March 2** at 10am.
 - Icette Program/Upper Level starting **Wednesday, March 4** at 10am.
 - All other program participants starting **Thursday, March 5** at 10am.

GENERAL TICKET SALES INFORMATION

- General ticket sales open on **Friday, March 6** at 10am.
- There are no refunds or exchanges after tickets have been purchased.
- Skaters in Basic 5 & above may watch the production in the skater's stands free of charge (no supervision).
- All seats are reserved and priced at \$14 or \$16 depending on location (see seating chart below).
- For the best experience, you may purchase tickets online anytime. If needed, you may purchase tickets at the front desk during registration hours (typically M-F 9am-8pm and Sat-Sun 9am-5pm).
 - Tickets CANNOT be purchased over the phone.
- ADA seating is designed to accommodate patrons with disabilities. One companion seat can be purchased with one ADA seat. The companion seat will be assigned directly behind the ADA seat purchased. Please only purchase ADA and companion seats if you need them, as availability in these sections is limited and closely monitored.
